#### **Update from Kathy Walgren**

Lori was diagnosed in May with stage 4 cancer and is scheduled to have a Pep Scan this week to trace the cancer cells in her body and to see if the cancer has spread. When they did the surgery to remove the tumor and nodules in her body, they were able to get 99%, but if they had gotten any closer to the aorta, it would have killed her. They saw cancer cells in the lining of her lungs and cannot touch these except through radiation or chemo. The docs plan on radiation daily and chemo 3 times a week. Lori's energy is low due to the meds and treatments, but conserves what energy she can to do things with her children (10, 4 and twins - 8). During surgery, they nicked the vocal cord so when Lori talks, it is a strain to get volume. In addition, the expenses are huge. Co-pays for meds are sometime \$100, and they have to pay up front for the Chemo, as the insurance has already paid all they can for the year (2006). They need a miracle! Thank you for your prayers and assistance.
